STEP 2: APPLY ONLINE

Applications to St. George's are made through our online application process. To set up your profile, click *BEGIN YOUR APPLICATION* on our website to tell us a little bit about your family. The Admissions Team will set up your profile and you will receive your username and password via email.

You will then be able to submit the application form and supporting documentation by uploading them directly to your profile. We recommend that you check your profile regularly for updates and notifications.
