STEP 2: APPLY ONLINE

Applications to St. George's are made through our online application process. In order to access the application you must first set up your family profile by clicking on CREATE A PROFILE.

Once your profile has been created you will be able to complete the application form. You will be able to submit the supporting documentation by uploading them directly to your profile. We recommend that you check your profile regularly for updates and notifications.

The following documents must accompany an application:

- 1 - the Confidential School Report Form (Grade 3-11) to be submitted by your child's current teacher by email directly to the Enrolment Office at St. George's.
- 2 - an authenticated copy or true copy (but not photocopy) of your child's birth certificate which must include full names of both parents (this must be in either English or French). If a translated document is submitted, a copy of the original document must be provided as well;
- 3 - a copy of your child's most recent report card **AND** a copy of your child's final report card for the past two academic years;
- 4 - a recent wallet-sized photograph of your child with his/her name and the grade to which he/she is applying written on the back. Please note this photo will not be returned;
- 5 - a copy of their *Déclaration d'admissibilité à l'enseignement en Anglais* (English eligibility certificate) issued by the Ministry of Education;
- 6 - if applicable, a copy of your child's educational assessments; and
- 7 - a cheque, payable to St. George's School of Montreal, cash, or online payment (via your family's profile) in the amount of \$50.00 representing a non-refundable application fee.

STEP 3: ADMISSION TEST

Following the receipt of a complete application package, students will be asked to [register with Brisson Legris for their Admission Test.](#)

STEP 4: FAMILY INTERVIEW

Family interviews will be scheduled following the receipt of your family's completed applications.

STEP 5: DECISION

Once the Admissions process is complete (Step 1-4), families will be notified of the Admissions Committee's recommendations.

Grade 7

St. George's follows the QAIS best practice admission guidelines and will begin notifying families as of November 9, 2018.

Grades 8-11

Families will be notified of the Admissions Committee's recommendations as of March 15, 2019 or two weeks after the Family Interview.

Please note that applications are accepted year-round and are considered on a rolling basis depending upon grade-specific availability. Students will be required to complete steps 1-4, and families will be notified of the Admissions Committee's decision two weeks after the classroom visit.
