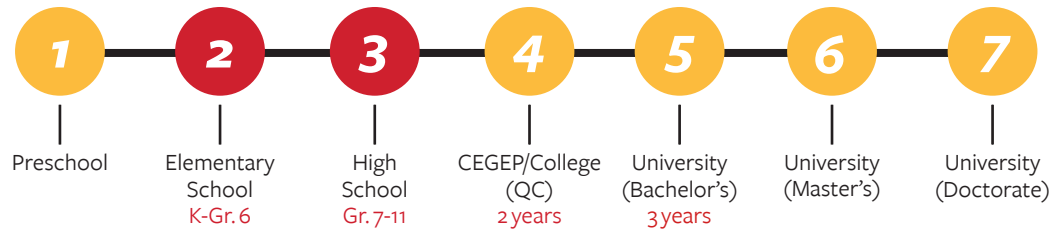


HOW TO APPLY INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Quebec School System



STEP 1: APPLY ONLINE

Applications to St. George's are made through our online application process. To set up your profile, click [BEGIN YOUR APPLICATION](#) on our website to tell us a little bit about your family. The Admissions Team will set up your profile and you will receive your username and password via email.

You will then be able to submit the application form and supporting documentation by uploading them directly to your profile. We recommend that you check your profile regularly for updates and notifications.

STEP 2: ADMISSION TEST

Following the receipt of a complete application package, St. George's will coordinate the scheduling of the exam with your child's current school. The contact information of a teacher at your child's current school who would be willing to proctor the Entrance Exam will be required as part of the application form.

STEP 3: FAMILY INTERVIEW

Family interviews will be scheduled following the receipt of your child's admission test results. At least one parent is required to participate in the interview, with the help of a translator if necessary. This will give you the opportunity ask questions and most importantly, discover what goes into developing the confident, fascinating, multifaceted person within every child. Email notifications will be sent to the email address(es) provided in your profile to schedule a meeting in person or using videoconferencing technology (Ex: Skype, FaceTime, WeChat, WhatsApp).

STEP 4: DECISION

Once the Admissions process is complete (Step 1-3), families will be notified of the Admissions Committee's recommendations after March 16, 2020, or as space becomes available.

PLEASE NOTE: If a student is accepted to St. George's, your family will be required to submit a valid CAQ and Study Permit to enrol.

LATE APPLICATIONS

Please note that applications are accepted year-round and are considered on a rolling basis depending upon grade-specific availability. Students will be required to complete steps 1-3, and families will be notified of the Admissions Committee's decision.

The following documents must accompany an application:

- 1- the Confidential School Report Form (Kindergarten-Grade 2 **OR** Grade 3-11) to be submitted by your child's current teacher by email directly to the Enrolment Office at St. George's.
- 2- an authenticated copy or true copy (but not photocopy) of your child's birth certificate which must include full names of both parents (this must be in either English or French). If a translated document is submitted, a copy of the original document must be provided as well;
- 3- a copy of your child's most recent report card **AND** a copy of your child's final report card for the past two academic years;
- 4- a recent wallet-sized photograph of your child with his/her name and the grade to which he/she is applying written on the back. Please note this photo will not be returned;
- 5- a copy of their *Déclaration d'admissibilité à l'enseignement en Anglais* (English eligibility certificate) issued by the Ministry of Education;
- 6- if applicable, a copy of your child's educational assessments; and
- 7- a cheque, payable to St. George's School of Montreal, cash, or online payment (via your family's profile) in the amount of \$250.00 representing a non-refundable application fee.
