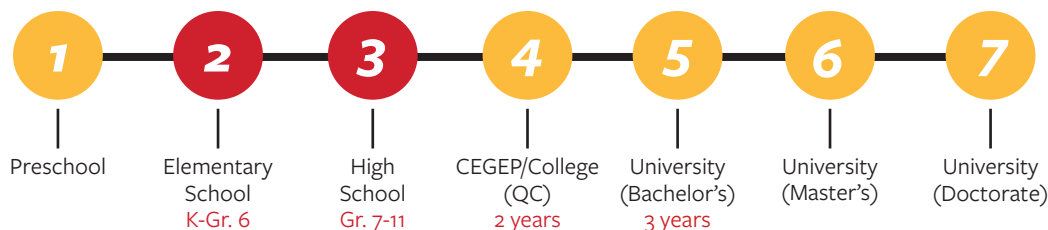


HOW TO APPLY INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Quebec School System



STEP 1: APPLY ONLINE

To set up your online profile, click [BEGIN YOUR APPLICATION](#) on our website to tell us a little bit about your family. Once the inquiry form is received, the Admissions Team will set up your profile and you will receive your username and password via email.

Once logged into your online profile, you will be able to submit the application form and a non-refundable application fee of \$250 CAD. Additionally, you will be requested to upload supporting documentation directly to your profile.

STEP 2: ADMISSION TEST (GRADES 7-11)

St. George's will coordinate the scheduling of the test with your child's current school. In the application form, you will be required to provide the contact information of a teacher at your child's current school, who would be willing to proctor the Admission Test.

Admission tests have been suspended, until further notice, for international students who are currently attending a Canadian School.

STEP 3: FAMILY INTERVIEW

Family interviews will be scheduled following the receipt of your child's admission test results. At least one parent is required to participate in the interview, with the help of a translator if necessary. This will give you the opportunity to ask questions and most importantly, discover what goes into developing the confident, fascinating, multifaceted person within every child. Email notifications will be sent to the email address(es) provided in your profile to schedule a meeting using videoconferencing technology (eg. Zoom).

STEP 4: DECISION

Once the Admissions process is complete (Step 1-3), families will be notified of the Admissions Committee's recommendations on a rolling basis, after the application deadline, or as a space becomes available.

PLEASE NOTE: If a student is accepted to St. George's, your family will be required to submit a valid CAQ and Study Permit to enrol.

LATE APPLICATIONS

Please note that applications are accepted year-round and are considered on a rolling basis depending upon grade-specific availability. Students will be required to complete steps 1-3, and families will be notified of the Admissions Committee's decision.

Required Supporting documentation:

- 1 - A Recommendation form to be completed by your child's current teacher, and submitted directly to the Enrolment Office at St. George's.
- 2 - Birth certificate; If the original birth certificate is not in English or French, an official translation must be provided.
- 3 - A copy of your child's most recent report card **AND** a copy of your child's final report cards for the past two academic years;
- 5 - A copy of their *Déclaration d'admissibilité à l'enseignement en Anglais* (English Eligibility Certificate) issued by the Ministry of Education (if already obtained);
- 6 - A copy of your child's educational assessments (if applicable);
- 7 - A CAQ (Quebec Acceptance Certificate) and the Study Permit (if already obtained)

St. George's Homestay Program (Grades 8-11)

For students who wish to study in Montreal, without an accompanying parent ask us about our homestay program. Your child may be accommodated by one of our homestay families! Homestay Families are faculty, staff, parents, alumni and friends of the St. George's community.
