MERIT-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

St. George's School of Montreal is pleased to offer merit-based scholarships. Three merit-based scholarships will be awarded per year in the amount of \$10,000 each, in increments of \$2,000 annually over five years, and applied directly toward school tuition and fees. This scholarship program has been designed in alignment with St. George's Mission. Eligible students will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Academic performance (a minimum of 85% required on the entrance exam. All applicants will be required to take this exam and incur any related costs, including St. George's students.)
- Extra-curricular contributions to school life and community
- Character traits, as demonstrated through personal commitment and engagement in school and community

BEGIN YOUR APPLICATION ➤

STEP 1:

Indicate that your family will be applying for a scholarship in your child's application for admission to St. George's School of Montreal.

STEP 2:

Upload your complete package of supporting documents as one PDF document no later than October 22, 2021.

STEP 3:

Students who are eligible for scholarships will participate in a private interview (without parents) as an extension of the Admissions interview process. The interview will provide the applicant the opportunity to elaborate upon their accomplishments in areas such as community service, leadership, music, arts, athletics, citizenship, character and overall engagement.

Your package of supporting documents should include:

- A list of three and a maximum of five extra-curricular activities or accomplishments that you believe will help demonstrate at least three areas of your child's extra-curricular involvement. Please provide a brief description of each one as well as at least one of the following for each activity: Referral letter, certificate(s), award(s), proof of accomplishment, etc.
- Please include a letter written by your child indicating his/her accomplishments, and their personal meaning, in areas such as community service, leadership, music, arts, athletics, citizenship, character and overall engagement in school and community life.
 - The letter should be approximately 200-400 word and type written.
