

HOW TO APPLY INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International Students require a study permit and a CAQ (Certificat d'acceptation du Quebec) to study in Canada. This does not include students accompanying parents on study permits or work permits or diplomatic status.

STEP 1: APPLY ONLINE

To set up your online profile, click [Create Your Admission Profile](#) on our website to tell us a little bit about your family. Once the inquiry form is received, the Admissions Team will set up your profile and you will receive your username and password via email.

Once logged into your online profile, you will be able to submit the application form and a non-refundable application fee of \$250 CAD. Additionally, you will be requested to upload supporting documentation directly to your profile.

Required Supporting Documents:

- 1 - Birth certificate (Official translation in English or French);
- 2 - A recommendation form to be completed by your child's current teacher;
- 3 - Most recent report card;
- 4 - Final report cards for the past two academic years;
- 5 - A copy of your child's educational assessments (if applicable);
- 6 - A CAQ (Quebec Acceptance Certificate) and the Study Permit (if already obtained).

Kindergarten

Readiness process will be discussed at the family interview.

Grades 1-6

Assessment will be included as part of the interview.

Grades 8-11

Admission test required for Grade 8-11 students attending a school outside of Quebec
The admission test will be proctored by your child's current school.

STEP 3: FAMILY INTERVIEW

Family interviews will be scheduled following the receipt of your child's admission test results (if applicable). The meetings will be scheduled using video conferencing technology (eg. Zoom).

STEP 4: DECISION

Once the Admissions process is complete (Step 1-3), families will be notified of the Admissions Committee's recommendations on a rolling basis, after the application deadline, or as a space becomes available.

PLEASE NOTE: If a student is accepted to St. George's, your family will be required to submit a valid CAQ and Study Permit.

LATE APPLICATIONS

Please note that applications are accepted year-round and are considered on a rolling basis depending upon grade-specific availability. Students will be required to complete steps 1-3, and families will be notified of the Admissions Committee's decision.
